LOW-MAINTENANCE PEACHTREE 300 SERIES DELIVERS RELIABILITY AND VALUE

MOSINEE, Wis., — The 300 Series from Peachtree® Doors and Windows is a full line of windows and patio doors with low-maintenance vinyl exteriors, appealing wood interiors and reliable construction details one may not expect on a value-priced line.

“The 300 Series offers features and options not found on comparable product lines,” said Jeff Kibler, Peachtree brand manager. “Finer details such as traditional profiled wood interiors, recessed double-hung locks, and a folding nested handle on the casements set the 300 Series apart. This line combines beauty and quality while remaining cost-conscious.”

The 300 Series’ reliability starts with its composition. Full 4-9/16” frames, and multi-chambered, extruded vinyl exteriors deliver superior structural stability. Fusion-welded corners on the exteriors provide an impenetrable barrier against wind and rain. The exteriors, in White or Tan, have titanium dioxide stabilizers and high-impact acrylic modifiers that minimize fading caused by the sun. All units have an integral nailing fin to assist with proper installation.

Inside the home, the 300 Series has many options for developing a personalized look. Homeowners can choose from standard pine interiors or ash, which resembles the texture of oak. Both can be primed or prestained in one of four finishes: Clear Satin, Golden Oak, Chestnut and Fruitwood. Pine is also available in prefinished white. Prefinished white composite interiors also are an option on premium double hung units. Other options include color-matched 5/8” flat and 3/4” Grilles-Between-The-Glass (GBG), 7/8” Value Divided Lites (VDL), Optically Divided Lites (ODL) and Interior Snap-in Wood Grilles for even greater appeal.

The 300 Series styles suit any home and homeowner: casement, awning, double hung, double slider and specialty-shaped windows. Double hung and casement units are available in mulled, stacked, multiple-wide, and bay and bow configurations. A simulated transom—in rectangular, eyebrow, half circle and gothic configurations—is an option on premium double hung units, delivering the added light and look of a mulled transom at a fraction of the cost.

Both the 300 Series standard and premium double hung units feature tilt-in sash that allow the exteriors to be cleaned from the inside. Block-and-tackle balance systems ensure the units open and close effortlessly for years. The premium double hung has flush-mounted tilt latches and low-profile, cam-action locks and a non-rot, composite sill, all ensuring years of worry-free use. The standard double hung has a low-maintenance vinyl sill and reliable surface-mounted hardware.

Patio door styles on the 300 Series include center-hinged, and French in-swing and out-swing hinged patio doors; and traditional sliding patio doors in single or multiple panel configurations.

Sliding patio doors feature adjustable, tandem ball-bearing rollers that glide smoothly for years. Standard tempered insulated glass and an easy-locking security foot bolt delivers added protection against intruders. A one-piece, pultruded fiberglass sill system and full-perimeter weather stripping reduce leaks, drafts and energy use. Tempered insulated glass, adjustable hinges, secure locks, and a number of handle styles and finishes.

Hinged patio doors in the 300 Series feature a classic French door design, with wide stiles and rails and distinctive Classic Curve or Contemporary handle sets in a choice of eight finishes. Every operating panel comes with four adjustable hinges to ensure a proper fit, free swinging and an energy-efficient seal. Multipoint locking systems are optional on 6'8" or 6'10" doors and standard on 8'0" units.

Standard window glazing is 3/4" insulated glass with a Real Warm Edge[®] spacer system that reduces temperature variance and condensation on the glass. For greater energy efficiency, the 300 Series can be ordered with Zo-e-shield[™] 5, which improves U-factors by 50 percent and solar heat gain coefficients by 65 percent over clear insulated glass. Low-E² glass with argon-filled airspace, or EasyCare[®] Low-E² glass, which resists dirt and water, also are available.
