PEACHTREE OFFERS THE BEST OF BOTH DOORS: SMOOTH EXTERIOR, TEXTURED INTERIOR FIBERGLASS ENTRY DOORS

GAINESVILLE, Ga. - Peachtree® Doors & Windows unveiled today the latest options available in its entry door line, including a smooth exterior/textured interior fiberglass panel. The new panel design in the Newport premium fiberglass entry door line is designed for homeowners who want the look of a wood door inside and the clean appearance of a smooth door outside.

“We are continuously looking at new styles, design improvements and decorative features that will appeal to homeowners’ varied preferences,” said Jeff Kibler, Peachtree brand manager. “The smooth exterior/textured interior door is often requested because it provides a beautiful, low-maintenance, non-rot alternative to wood doors that also provide greater energy performance.”

The exterior of the smooth exterior/textured interior door can be finished in one of six standard colors: Classic White, Ivory, Pebble Tan, Tan, Forest Green or Sierra Brown. The interior panel can be stained to bring out the wood-grain appearance of the textured fiberglass panel. Stain kits are available in Dark Mahogany, Dark Walnut Provincial, Early American, Golden Oak and Red Mahogany.

Peachtree entry doors are available in 6'8" and 8'0" options with 1/2-view and 3/4-view oval, round top and rectangle style windows. Seven decorative glass patterns,

ranging from intricate floral designs to geometric and frosted glass patterns, can enhance and tailor an entry door system. Coming in the decorative glass will vary by pattern, but is generally available in brass or zinc. Dynasty and Mission patterns are available with black patina coming. Flush glazing tightly seals the window into the door panel, minimizing energy loss and providing cleaner sightlines.

Peachtree entry systems have a patented, virtually maintenance-free sill that resists moisture and rot by keeping the wood jamb above the water source. An integrated frame system that encases the door panel, sidelites, and transom creates a more durable unit that is easier to install and provides greater structural strength than mullied units. Peachtree's entry door frame is available in six standard aluminum clad colors to match Peachtree's 500 Series windows and patio doors.

Other Peachtree Entry Door Options

The smooth exterior/textured interior fiberglass panel is one of the many panel styles available in the Newport entry door line. Homeowners and builders may opt for fiberglass entry doors that are smooth inside and out, or textured on the interior and exterior. The smooth fiberglass panels can be painted; the textured fiberglass panels can be stained to bring out the wood-grain appearance. The long-lasting finish won't rot, crack or split.

Avanti, Peachtree's reliable steel entry door, is more durable than wood and requires less maintenance. The galvanized steel panels won't warp, rot, split or crack. They come primed and ready to paint to accent any home's color scheme. Both Newport and Avanti systems have polyurethane cores that are six times more energy efficient than wood doors.
